EPHESIANS 3

1. What does Paul say he is and for whom? (verse 1) **Prisoner of Christ Jesus; Gentiles**
2. What was given to Paul for those to whom he was writing? (verse 2) **grace of God**
3. What was made known to Paul? (verse 3) **the mystery (of Christ)**
4. How was it made known to Paul? (verse 4) **by revelation**
5. "...which in other ages was not made known to the sons of men, as it has now been revealed by the Spirit to his holy apostles and prophets:"(verse 5)
6. "...that the Gentiles should be fellow heirs, of the same body, and partakers of His promise in Christ through the gospel..." (verse 6)
7. In verse 7, what does Paul say he has become? **a minister**
8. How does Paul say the gift of the grace of God was given to him? (verse 7) **by the effective working of His power**
9. In verse 8, what does Paul say he is? **Less than the least of all the saints**
10. This measure of grace was given so Paul could preach what to the Gentiles? (verse 8) **The unsearchable riches of Christ**
11. "...and to make all see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the ages has been hidden in God who created all things through Jesus Christ;" (verse 9)
12. What do we have in Christ Jesus through faith in Him? (verse 12) **boldness and access with confidence**
13. What does Paul tell the Ephesians **not** to do? (verse 13) **lose heart at his tribulations for them**
14. What does Paul do in verse 14? **Bows his knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ**
15. "...that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and breadth and height—" (verses 16-18)

16. What does verse 19 say the love of Christ passes? **Knowledge**
17. What does Paul want the Ephesians to be filled with? **Fullness of God**
18. “Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly **abundantly** above all that we **ask** or **think**, according to the **power** that works in us, to Him be **glory** in the **church** by **Christ Jesus** to all generations, **forever** and **ever**. Amen.” (verses 20-21)
